The Challenge

Those active in the oil and gas industry know that drilling, producing, and transporting petroleum-based commodities are inherently risky, and that identifying, managing, and mitigating risk are the most important issues facing the industry. But equally important is **risk management in procurement**, where supply chain professionals must select the safest suppliers and contractors for a job.

Operational risk management processes for drilling, producing, and transporting oil and gas products are firmly in place with functions that continuously monitor

each of those activities. Equally vital is that procurement professionals monitor each supplier's business and performance risk factors to ensure that neither external nor internal risks arise when those materials, equipment, or services are put into use. However, this responsibility involves proactively monitoring millions of suppliers and their agents worldwide. Supplier risk management is compounded by the fact that the software used is often not integrated with enterprise resource planning (ERP) or procurement software. This means that procurement professionals cannot be sure only risk-compliant suppliers and contractors are selected for specific jobs. But that aspect is changing.

Statistics from the United States Department of Labor indicate that, from 2000 to 2009, pipeline accidents accounted for 2,554 significant incidents, 161 fatalities, and 576 injuries in the United States.
